

5 Star Hotels in Andaman Port Blair: Best Luxury Stays to Book in 2026



If you are booking 5 star hotels in Andaman Port Blair for an upcoming trip, you already know the stakes. Port Blair is the gateway to every island in the Andaman chain, and the hotel you pick here sets the tone for your entire holiday, from the quality of your first breakfast after a long flight to how quickly you can get to Cellular Jail, Corbyn's Cove Beach or the ferry jetty for Havelock and Neil Island. This guide lists the actual 5 star and luxury-grade properties operating in Port Blair right now, tells you honestly what separates a true 5 star hotel from an OTA label, and walks you through how to book one without overpaying or getting stuck with a mismatched room.

Why Port Blair Deserves a Proper 5 Star Base

Most Andaman itineraries treat Port Blair as a stopover between flights and ferries. That is a mistake if you can afford to do it properly. Port Blair holds the airport, the main hospitals, the best multi-cuisine restaurants in the islands, and the only stretch of coastline where you get city convenience and sea views in the same neighbourhood. A 5 star hotel here means you land after a five or six hour flight from Delhi or Mumbai, get a proper shower and a real bed

instead of a budget guesthouse mattress, and start your island-hopping the next morning rested rather than drained.

There is also a practical reason to spend your first and last night in a higher category hotel. Flights to Port Blair are limited in number and get delayed often during monsoon months. A comfortable hotel with a lounge, a pool and dependable air conditioning makes a six hour delay bearable instead of miserable. If your trip includes Havelock or Neil Island later, treat Port Blair as the bookend nights where you actually want the extra comfort.

What Counts as a 5 Star Hotel in Port Blair

Here is where most blogs mislead you. Booking platforms often tag a property as "5-star" based on price bracket or amenities checklist rather than an official star classification. In reality, Port Blair has one internationally branded, formally rated 5 star hotel, the Welcomhotel by ITC Hotels on Bay Island. Everything else that shows up under a "5-star" filter on Booking.com or Expedia, including Sampat Regency and some Lemon Tree properties, is closer to an upscale 4 star business hotel with premium pricing rather than a resort-grade luxury property.

That does not make those hotels a bad choice. It means you should judge them on what they actually deliver, room quality, service consistency, location and facilities, rather than the star badge alone. Below is an honest shortlist covering the true 5 star option plus the upscale properties worth comparing against it.

The Best 5 Star and Luxury Hotels in Port Blair

Welcomhotel by ITC Hotels, Bay Island

This is the only hotel in Port Blair with a genuine 5 star classification, and it earns the label. Set on Marine Hill overlooking the Bay of Bengal, it is a twelve minute walk from Cellular Jail and about five minutes by car from Veer Savarkar International Airport, which matters when you are managing tight ferry connections. The property runs 46 air conditioned rooms with sea or garden views, an outdoor pool, a full service spa, a 24 hour gym and two dining venues, WelcomCafe Bay Leaf for international cuisine and the Swizzle Bar for evening drinks. Guest reviews consistently praise the staff's attentiveness and the sunset views from the bay-facing rooms. Room rates typically start around eight to ten thousand rupees a night for a Deluxe Room and climb from there for Superior and Suite categories with bay views. If your priority is a genuine luxury experience with brand consistency, book this one first and compare everything else against it.

Sinclairs Bayview Port Blair

Sinclairs sits directly on Corbyn's Cove Road, close enough to the beach that you can walk down for a swim before dinner. It is not internationally star-rated but functions as a solid upscale property with sea-facing rooms, a multi-cuisine restaurant and dependable service that regular Andaman travellers keep coming back to. Families and couples who want beach

proximity over city center convenience tend to prefer this over hotels closer to Aberdeen Bazaar.

Symphony Samudra Beachside Jungle Resort and Spa

This resort blends beachfront and forest surroundings, which gives it a different character from the more conventional city hotels. Tripadvisor consistently ranks it among the top luxury stays in Port Blair. The spa and the beachside setting make it a strong pick for a honeymoon or anniversary trip where you want privacy over nightlife.

Sampat Regency

Sampat Regency is a well-established upscale hotel around fifteen miles from Mahatma Gandhi Marine National Park, with an outdoor pool, room service and steady mid-to-upper pricing. It gets tagged as 5 star on several booking platforms because of its amenity list, and while it does not match the Welcomhotel's brand polish, it is a reliable choice if that property is sold out on your travel dates.

Lemon Tree Hotel, Port Blair Near Airport

As the name suggests, the biggest advantage here is the airport location, useful if you land late or have an early morning flight out. The Lemon Tree brand is known across India for consistent service standards, a reliable breakfast spread and a bar on-site. It suits business travellers and anyone who wants zero commute stress on arrival or departure day.

Sea Shell Coral Cove

A four star spa hotel that regularly appears in luxury shortlists for Port Blair thanks to its free breakfast, free parking and quiet residential location near School Line. It works well if you want a calmer stay away from the main tourist strip while still being a short drive from the city center.

Comparing Room Categories Before You Pay a Premium

Hotels rarely explain why a Deluxe Room and a Superior Room at the same property can differ by two to three thousand rupees a night, and the answer usually comes down to view and floor level rather than square footage. At the Welcomhotel, a Deluxe Room runs around 247 square feet with a garden or partial view, while the Superior category adds a direct bay view and slightly better placement within the property. Unless you specifically want to wake up to open water, the Deluxe category delivers the same air conditioning, the same bathrobes and toiletries, and the same access to the pool and spa for less money. The same logic applies at Sampat Regency and Sinclairs Bayview, where the jump from a standard room to a sea-facing room is almost entirely about the window, not the furniture or service level inside it.

Suites are worth the extra spend only in specific situations, a honeymoon, an anniversary, or a stay where you plan to spend significant daytime hours in the room itself rather than out on excursions. If your days are packed with Cellular Jail visits, ferry departures and beach time, you will barely see the room in daylight, which makes the standard or deluxe category the more rational booking for most travellers.

How to Choose Between These Hotels

Location Against Your Itinerary

Decide this before you decide anything else. If most of your Port Blair time is spent visiting Cellular Jail, Marina Park and the local market, a hotel near Aberdeen Bazaar or Marine Hill like the Welcomhotel saves you commute time. If you are catching an early ferry to Havelock or an early flight home, Lemon Tree's airport proximity or a hotel near Phoenix Bay Jetty becomes more valuable than a scenic room with a longer drive attached.

What the Room Rate Actually Includes

Andaman hotel pricing swings hard between peak season, which runs from November through February, and the monsoon months of June through September, when rates can drop by 30 to 40 percent. Always confirm whether breakfast, airport transfer and taxes are included in the quoted rate, since a hotel that looks cheaper upfront can end up costing more once these are added separately at check-in.

Reviews From the Last Six Months, Not the Last Three Years

Andaman hotel staff and management change often, and a property that had excellent reviews two years ago can decline sharply without a warning sign anywhere on its listing page. Filter reviews on Tripadvisor or Booking.com to the most recent six months before trusting a rating.

Proximity to the Beach Versus Proximity to the City

Corbyn's Cove hotels like Sinclairs give you beach access but a longer drive into town for shopping, permits or hospital visits if needed. City-center hotels near Aberdeen Bazaar or Marine Hill put you closer to everything except a walkable beach. Neither is objectively better, it depends on whether you are treating Port Blair as a base for excursions or as a beach holiday in its own right.

Who Each Hotel Actually Suits

Couples on a honeymoon tend to get the most out of Symphony Samudra or the bay-view rooms at the Welcomhotel, where the setting does more of the work than the itinerary. Families travelling with kids usually do better at Sea Shell Coral Cove or Sinclairs Bayview, where the pace is calmer and the pool areas are less formal. Business and short-stay travellers who only need one or two nights before an early flight get the most value from Lemon Tree's airport location, since the time saved on transfers matters more than an extra

amenity or two. If you are unsure which category fits your trip, matching the hotel to your daily schedule works better than matching it to star rating alone.

Booking Your Stay the Right Way

Once you have shortlisted two or three hotels from the list above, the smartest move is to book through a local operator who can bundle your hotel with airport transfers, ferry tickets and sightseeing rather than booking each piece separately. Andaman Discover lists [luxury hotels in Port Blair](#) alongside deluxe, premium and standard categories, so you can compare real-time pricing against your travel dates instead of guessing from outdated blog rates. If you are planning a longer trip that covers Havelock and Neil Island as well, it is usually cheaper to book a [luxury Andaman package](#) that folds in hotel nights, cabs and ferry transfers as one quote rather than negotiating each vendor separately once you land.

For travellers who want a fully custom plan, for example a specific mix of nights at the Welcomhotel and a few nights at a Havelock resort, reaching out through the [customize tour plan](#) page gets you a quote built around your actual dates and group size rather than a generic package.

Getting to Port Blair and What You Need to Carry

Port Blair is served by Veer Savarkar International Airport, which despite the name only handles domestic flights from Delhi, Mumbai, Kolkata, Chennai, Bengaluru and a few other cities, alongside limited international charter routes. Indian citizens do not need any special permit to visit Port Blair, Havelock or Neil Island, but you must carry a valid government photo ID such as an Aadhaar card, voter ID or driving licence for flight check-in and hotel registration. Foreign nationals need a Restricted Area Permit, which is issued free of cost on arrival at the airport for most nationalities and is valid for 30 days, though citizens of a small number of countries need prior clearance from the Ministry of Home Affairs. Confirm your specific requirement on the [Andaman and Nicobar Tourism portal](#) before you fly, since permit rules for a handful of remote islands beyond Havelock and Neil do change from time to time.

Once you land, your 5 star hotel of choice should ideally offer airport pickup, which most of the properties listed above provide either free or for a small surcharge. Check this at the time of booking rather than assuming it is included, since it saves you the hassle of negotiating a taxi fare after a long flight.

Things to Do Within Reach of Your Hotel

A 5 star hotel in Port Blair puts you within a short drive of the city's core attractions. The [Cellular Jail](#) is the most visited historical site in the islands and hosts a light and sound show most evenings that is worth building your first night around. [Corbyn's Cove Beach](#) is the closest usable beach to the city and a good option if you want sand and water without travelling to Havelock immediately. For a structured half day covering the jail, the local market and a couple of viewpoints, a [Port Blair city tour](#) is the easiest way to see the highlights without planning your own route.

Frequently Asked Questions

Is there an actual 5 star hotel in Port Blair, or are they all just marketed that way?

Welcomhotel by ITC Hotels, Bay Island is the one property in Port Blair with a genuine 5 star classification. Other hotels tagged as 5 star on booking platforms, such as Sampat Regency and some Lemon Tree listings, are priced and equipped like upscale hotels but are not formally rated at that level.

What is the average price for a 5 star hotel room in Port Blair?

Expect roughly eight to eleven thousand rupees a night for an entry-level room at the Welcomhotel during regular season, rising during the November to February peak and dropping by 30 to 40 percent during the June to September monsoon months. Upscale alternatives like Sampat Regency or Lemon Tree usually run somewhat lower.

Which 5 star hotel is closest to Port Blair airport?

Lemon Tree Hotel, Port Blair Near Airport offers the shortest commute if you have an early morning flight or a late arrival. Welcomhotel by ITC Hotels is also close, at roughly five minutes by car.

Do I need a permit to stay at a hotel in Port Blair?

Indian citizens need only a valid photo ID for hotel check-in, no special permit required. Foreign nationals need a Restricted Area Permit, issued free on arrival at the airport for most nationalities and valid for 30 days.

Is it better to book a 5 star hotel directly or through a local travel operator?

Booking through a local operator like Andaman Discover often works out cheaper when you need the hotel bundled with cabs, ferries and sightseeing, and it gives you a single point of contact if your flight or ferry schedule changes.

What is the best time of year to book a luxury hotel in Port Blair?

November through February offers the best weather but the highest rates and needs booking two to three months ahead. April to early May and September to October offer good weather at lower prices, while June to September brings the steepest discounts alongside monsoon rain.
